

Boeing Definition of Acceptance Authority Media (AAM)

Acceptance Authority Media (AAM) is media used to record the status of tasks / operations on product records during and upon completion of the development, manufacturing, modification, repair, and support processes

AS9100D Section 8.5.2 p. 4

When Acceptance Authority Media are used (e.g. stamps, electronic signatures, passwords) the organization shall establish controls for media

In order to ensure compliance we are asking you to incorporate the following internal action items:

- □ Review Completed Work Orders for Accuracy i.e. Omissions, Typos, Legibility etc.
- Review In-Process Work Orders to ensure documentation is completed as planned
- Evaluate your in-process and completed Work Orders & Training Records for uncertified / untrained personnel, falsification of documentation, work not performed as planned etc.
- □ Review Training Material to ensure it adequately communicates the importance of not falsifying records
- □ Flow this down to each of your relevant sub tier suppliers
